Deepak Raghavan co-founded Manhattan Associates, Inc., a global leader in supply chain solutions, in 1990 (<u>www.manh.com</u>), where he conceptualized, designed, and developed the industry's first "packaged" distribution management software for the consumer supply chain. Deepak's leadership in the development of customer-focused software products and implementation services has enabled Manhattan Associates to achieve a consistent track record of growth and profitability. Manhattan Associates is a publicly traded company, listed on NASDAQ (ticker: MANH).

While continuing to provide strategic and governance oversight as a director, Deepak left full-time employment at Manhattan Associates in June 2002 to pursue his passion for astronomy. His wonders about the countless stars and the possibility of other life-supporting environments led his research efforts, which are focused on a better understanding of the habitats of Sun-like stars.
